Pea Ridge National Military Park. Civil War battlefield, hiking and driving tours, visitor center, museum, theater, and bookstore. Open daily, seasonal hours vary. Pea Ridge, AR. 479-451-8122, ext. 227.

Thorncrow Chapel. Named number four on the AIA's list of Top Designs of the 20th Century. The

design recalls the Prairie School form of architecture popularized by Frank Lloyd Wright. Architect E. Fay Jones of Fayetteville, AR. 12968 Hwy 62 W, six miles west of downtown Eureka Springs. 479-253-7401.

Arkansas Country Doctor Museum. Six miles from the Prairie Grove Battlefield. Old medical equipment, a 1924 Model-T, garden with medicinal plants. Free admission. Open Wed-Sat, 1-4 p.m. 109 N. Starr Ave (2 blocks from US Hwy 62). Lincoln, AR. 479-824-4307.
